Description:

Height x Width: 2.2 x 2

Habit: Spreading and rounded.

Stems & leaves: Grey- brown arching stems and very large pale-green, smooth, glossy leaves that have a tendency to hang down, but not particularly attractive.

Panicles: Rounded to flattened panicles 150 x 150 mm. . Sterile flowers white with very large narrow well separated sepals creating star-like flowers and not turning pink, loosely covering 50% of the white fertile flowers.

Overall assessment: A very distinctive and attractive cultivar, the combination of large star-like flowers against pale green leaves is very good.

Origins: A branch mutation found on an unnamed seedling from paniculata 'Floribunda', selected by Greta Sturdza at Varengeville Sur-Mer, France in 2008.
