The leaves are large mid-green and glossy. **Panicles:** Large upright open panicles 300 x 200mm, with very large white sterile flowers that cover the creamy white fertile flowers by around 20% of the panicle, and hanging down at maturity showing dull pink reverse.

Overall assessment: The large sterile flowers and large panicles make this an attractive cultivar when in full flower.




