Hydrangea Derby is the largest collection (over 480 types) of Hydrangeas in UK and can be found near the Terrace Café in Darley Park, Derby. It is owned by Derby City Council but run by Friends of Darley Open Spaces (FoDOS) and its partners.

We have secured funding to continue to maintain and extend the collection this year. Another 71 new plants were added last year. The new gates of the walled collection will be open to the public for the fifth year running, between the end of July and the middle of October.
