

Hydrangea paniculata 'Sparkling'® Acc 1384

Synonyms: No synonyms found.

Awards: A recommendation at 'Courson Plant Days' in 2013.

Description:

Height x Width: 1 x 0.8 m

Habit: Dwarf compact habit.

Stems & leaves: Reddish brown ramified stems and smooth rounded leaves with occasional blunt serrations.

Panicles: Very early flowering, with small flattish panicles, more resembling a Lacecap hydrangea than a paniculata. It has a central cluster of white honey-like fragrant fertile flowers and around 50% cover of large white sterile flowers held upright on long pedicels and turning pink as they mature.

Overall assessment: An attractive and unusual cultivar that flowers very early and has a honey like fragrance. Needs to be viewed from above.
